

## Resurrection in the Old Testament

### Job 14:12-15

So man lies down and does not rise. Till the heavens *are* no more, They will not awake Nor be roused from their sleep. <sup>13</sup>Oh, that You would hide me in the grave, That You would conceal me until Your wrath is past, That You would appoint me a set time, and remember me! <sup>14</sup>If a man dies, shall he live *again*? All the days of my hard service I will wait, Till my change comes. <sup>15</sup>You shall call, and I will answer You; You shall desire the work of Your hands.

### Job 19:25-27

For I know *that* my Redeemer lives, And He shall stand at last on the earth; <sup>26</sup>And after my skin is destroyed, this *I know*, That in my flesh I shall see God, <sup>27</sup>Whom I shall see for myself, And my eyes shall behold, and not another. *How* my heart yearns within me!

### Psalms 16:9-10

Therefore my heart is glad, and my glory rejoices; My flesh also will rest in hope. <sup>10</sup>For You will not leave my soul in Sheol, Nor will You allow Your Holy One to see corruption.

### Psalms 17:15

As for me, I will see Your face in righteousness; I shall be satisfied when I awake in Your likeness.

### Psalms 49:15

But God will redeem my soul from the power of the grave, For He shall <sup>1</sup>receive me. Selah

### Isaiah 25:8

He will swallow up death forever, And the Lord GOD will wipe away tears from all faces; The rebuke of His people He will take away from all the earth; For the LORD has spoken.

### Isaiah 26:19

Your dead shall live; *Together with* my dead body they shall arise. Awake and sing, you who dwell in dust; For your dew *is like* the dew of herbs, And the earth shall cast out the dead.

### Ezekiel 37:1-14

**37** The hand of the LORD came upon me and brought me out in the Spirit of the LORD, and set me down in the midst of the valley; and it *was* full of bones. <sup>2</sup> Then He caused me to pass by them all around, and behold, *there were* very many in the open valley; and indeed *they were* very dry. <sup>3</sup> And He said to me, "Son of man, can these bones live?" So I answered, "O Lord GOD, You know." <sup>4</sup> Again He said to me, "Prophecy to these bones, and say to them, 'O dry bones, hear the word of the LORD!' <sup>5</sup> Thus says the Lord GOD to these bones: "Surely I will cause breath to enter into you, and you shall live. <sup>6</sup> I will put sinews on you and bring flesh upon you, cover you with skin and put breath in you; and you shall live. Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD." ' ' ' <sup>7</sup> So I prophesied as I was commanded; and as I prophesied, there was a noise, and suddenly a rattling; and the bones came together, bone to bone. Indeed, as I looked, the sinews and the flesh came upon them, and the skin covered them over; but *there was* no breath in them. <sup>9</sup> Also He said to me, "Prophecy to the breath, prophesy, son of man, and say to the breath, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Come from the four winds, O breath, and breathe on these slain, that they may live." ' ' ' <sup>10</sup> So I prophesied as He commanded me, and breath came into them, and they lived, and stood upon their feet, an exceedingly great army. <sup>11</sup> Then He said to me, "Son of man, these bones are the whole house of Israel. They indeed say, 'Our bones are dry, our hope is lost, and we ourselves are cut off!' <sup>12</sup> Therefore prophesy and say to them, 'Thus says the Lord GOD: "Behold, O My people, I will open your graves and cause you to come up from your graves, and bring you into the land of Israel. <sup>13</sup> Then you shall know that I *am* the LORD, when I have opened your graves, O My people, and brought you up from your graves. <sup>14</sup> I will put My Spirit in you, and you shall live, and I will place you in your own land. Then you shall know that I, the LORD, have spoken *it* and performed *it*," says the LORD.' ' "

**Daniel 12:2-3**

And many of those who sleep in the dust of the earth shall awake, Some to everlasting life, Some to shame *and* everlasting contempt. <sup>3</sup>Those who are wise shall shine Like the brightness of the firmament, And those who turn many to righteousness Like the stars forever and ever.

**Daniel 12:13**

“But you, go *your way* till the end; for you shall rest, and will arise to your inheritance at the end of the days.

**Hosea 13:14**

“I will ransom them from the power of the grave; I will redeem them from death. O Death, I will be your plagues! O Grave, I will be your destruction! Pity is hidden from My eyes.”

**Genesis 22:13 & Hebrews 11:17-19**

<sup>13</sup>Then Abraham lifted his eyes and looked, and there behind *him was* a ram caught in a thicket by its horns. So Abraham went and took the ram, and offered it up for a burnt offering instead of his son.

<sup>17</sup>By faith Abraham, when he was tested, offered up Isaac, and he who had received the promises offered up his only begotten *son*, <sup>18</sup>of whom it was said, “*In Isaac your seed shall be called,*” <sup>19</sup>concluding that God *was* able to raise *him* up, even from the dead, from which he also received him in a figurative sense.

**Jonah 2:10 & Matthew 12:40**

<sup>10</sup>So the LORD spoke to the fish, and it vomited Jonah onto dry *land*.

<sup>40</sup>For as Jonah was three days and three nights in the belly of the great fish, so will the Son of Man be three days and three nights in the heart of the earth.
